VENUE SPECIFIC INFORMATION

RAF Honington is an active RAF base so access to the site will require photo ID, e.g. a photo driving license, will be required for admittance to the site. Please obey all instructions given by RAF staff whilst on the base.

All people wanting access to the venue must give the following details to David Hicks, the BLSA Secretary (email secretary@theblsa.com or phone 01234 855767/07808 399523) by Tuesday 13th August or you will not be permitted to enter the site:

- Full name as it appears on your passport
- Date of Birth
- Nationality
- Address

If you are bringing a vehicle onto the venue, then you will need to provide the following vehicle details with the personal details above:

- Vehicle make
- Vehicle model
- Vehicle colour
- Registration number

Photo ID will be required to enter the venue.

The venue must be vacated by 1800 on the 18th August at the latest.

Parking will be on or near the runway and will be advised on arrival.

There is no camping available at the venue.

No dogs are allowed on the RAF base.

RACING RULES

Racing will be governed by the IBRA Rules, Edition 6. The full set of rules can be downloaded from the BLSA website.

IBRA rule E1 will be modified to use the Right-Hand rule, i.e. the blokart on the right has right of way whatever the wind direction. When two blokarts meet head-on they must both change course to their right.

Other changes may be made at the discretion of the Race Committee. Changes will be posted on the official Notice Board or notified at the briefing.

ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

Racing is open to all full BLSA members and any non-UK or non-ROI residents, see INSURANCE section below. UK and ROI residents must be a member of the BLSA.

Registration is via the BLSA website shop <http://www.theblsa.com/shop/> and payment is by PayPal (you do not need a PayPal account as all major credit and debit cards are accepted). Please note that you need to be logged in to the BLSA account of the person you are registering, so that if you are registering another member (e.g. a Junior or other family member) you will need to log out and log back in to their account.

Entries, complete with payment, must be in by Sunday 11th August 2019.

Late entries will be accepted at the discretion of the BLSA committee.

ENTRY FEES

The entry fee for the event for pilots is £25 for Adults and free for Juniors.

TRANSPONDERS

BLSA transponders will be available for first time racers at no charge or BLSA Members who only race once a year at a charge of £20. All other pilots **must** provide their own transponder.

INSURANCE

Each participant must be insured with valid third party liability insurance for at least £5m. BLSA members are covered. Non-UK and non-ROI residents will need to sign a declaration of insurance at registration.

As part of the insurance conditions, BLSA members must have their **own** sail numbers on all of the sails they use to participate in the event and carry their membership cards.

LUNCH

Lunch is not being provided so please bring your own. Tea and coffee will be available all day at the sailing area.

EVENING MEAL

Racing will be Production and Performance classes with the following weight categories:

Lightweight is up to and including 75kg

Middleweight is over 75 up to and including 95kg

Heavyweight is over 95kg

Pilots will be weighed in accordance with IBRA rule A5.

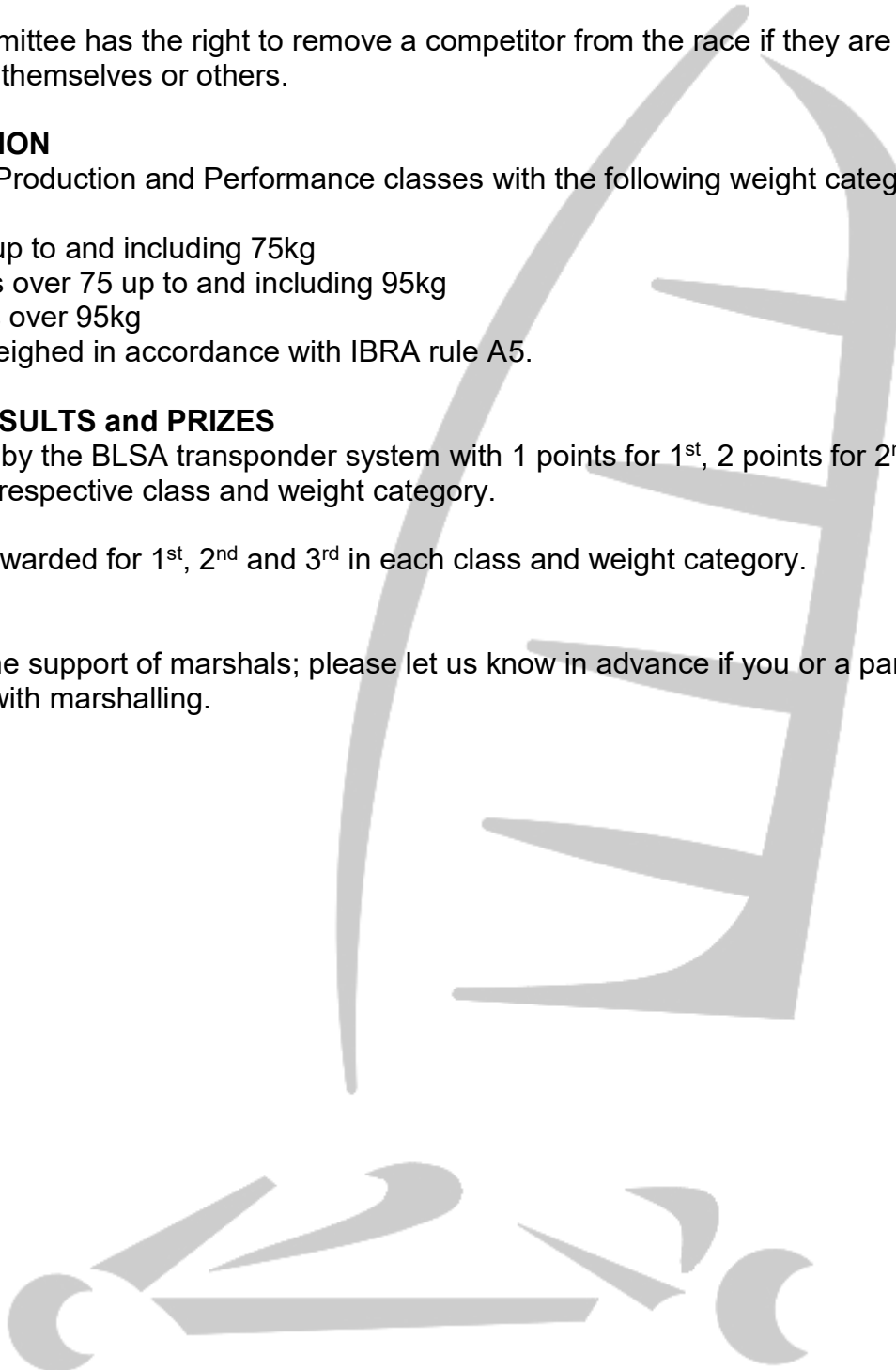
SCORING, RESULTS and PRIZES

Scoring will be by the BLSA transponder system with 1 points for 1st, 2 points for 2nd, 3 points for 3rd, etc., in the respective class and weight category.

Prizes will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd in each class and weight category.
